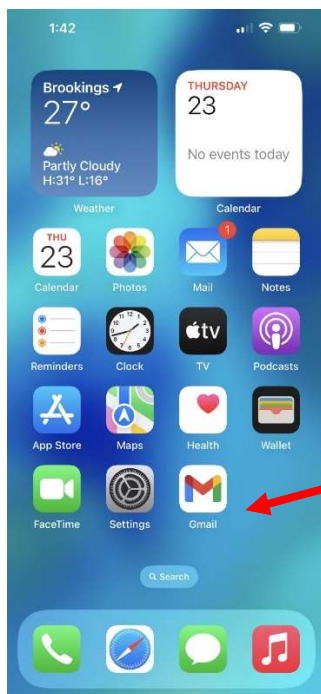
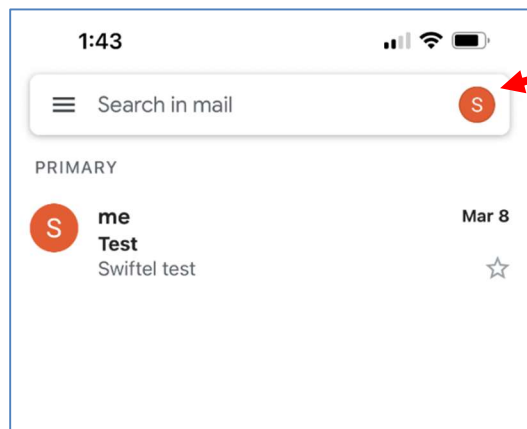


This tutorial is intended to assist Swiftel customers with setting up their swiftel.net or brookings.net email accounts in the Gmail app for iPhones with iOS 16.0 or newer (this tutorial was created using an iPhone running iOS v. 16.3.1).

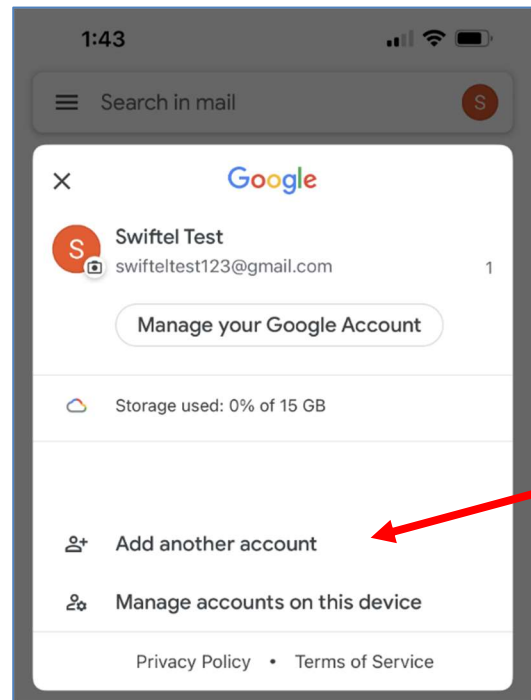
1) On your iPhone or iPad, open the Gmail app .



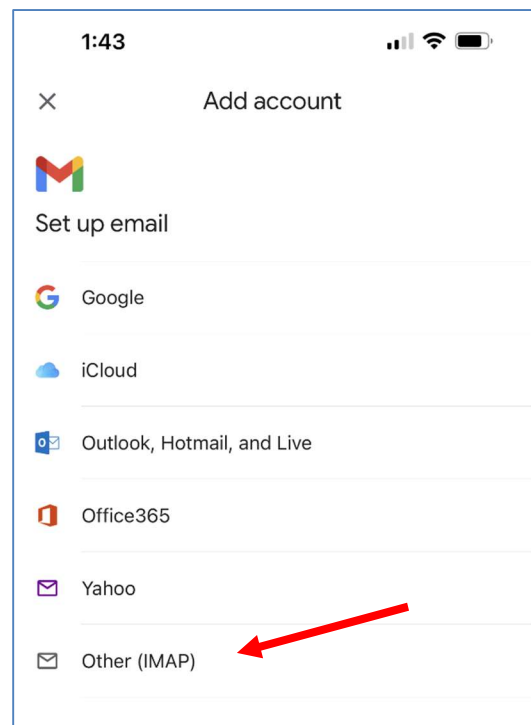
2) At the top right, tap your **Profile picture**.



3) Tap on **Add another account**.



4) Choose **Other (IMAP)**.



- 5) To add your account, fill in the information on the following screens.

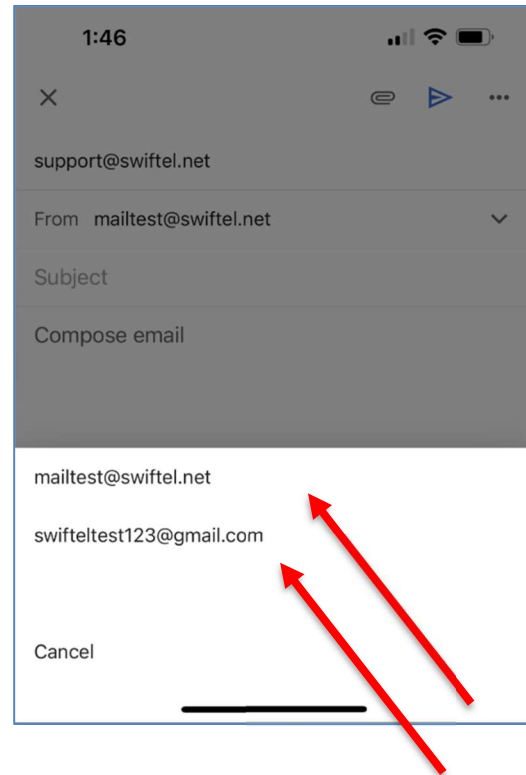
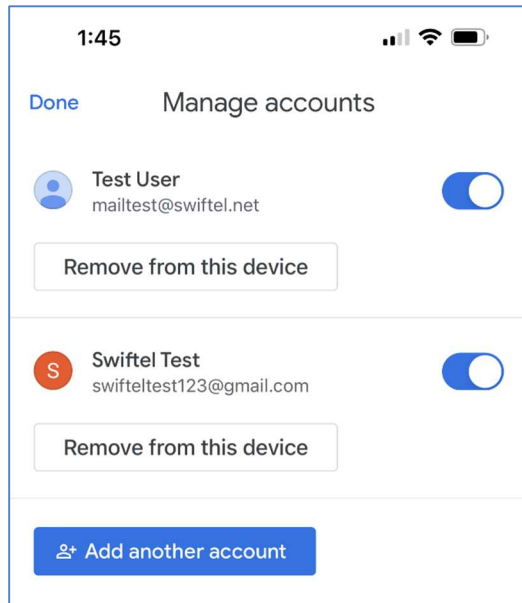

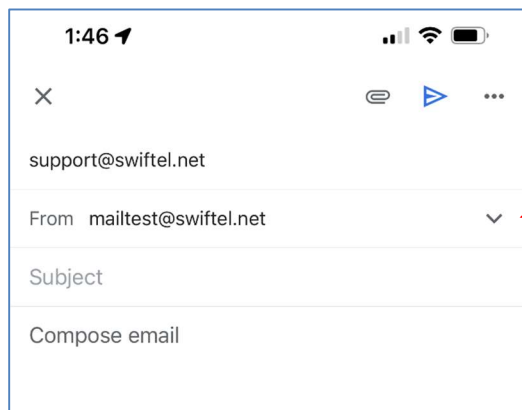
